



Learning the Ropes

Level 3

Cloister Doubles

Purpose

It can be used when you have few experienced ringers turn up to practice night. This method can be rung with 3 doubles ringers and 2 hunters (possibly not very experienced) and a tenor behind.

It is very useful for ringers learning to plain hunt as the ropesight is very easy.

Notes

Two bells hunt to thirds place:

- With a Plain Bob Start it is the **treble** and the **two**.
- With a Grandsire start it is the **two** and the **three**.

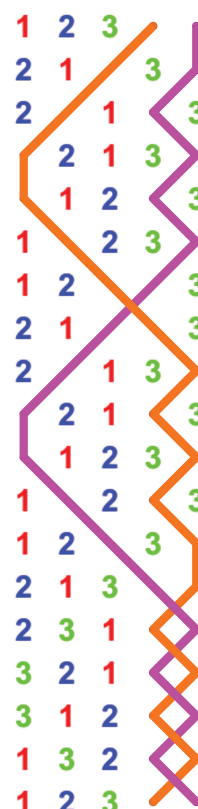
The other bells double dodge 4/5 up, lie and double dodge 4/5 down.

What next?

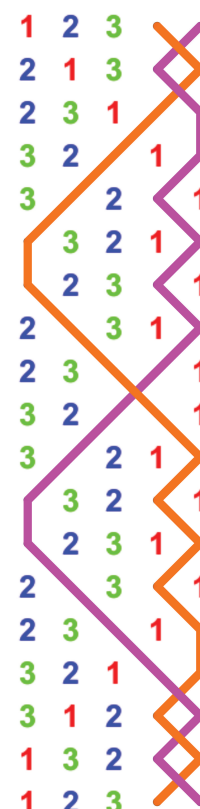
For a simple touch the conductor calls himself to make the single with the same bell twice.

The single is the same as a Stedman Doubles single.
